Regional Day 2021

Unfortunately, due to Covid and social distancing requirements, we will not be able to hold Regional Day in 2021. The number of participants allowable in our usual venue would be less than a third our usual attendance and a sufficiently large venue would be beyond our budget.

We are hoping to be able to hold our other usual events though – please see below for details of the first one.

Durham Spring School 14th - 16th April 2021

The North East Regional Committee need to ascertain the likely demand for the proposed Durham Spring School. It is hoped that the pandemic will be under control by April 2021 but we cannot be sure.

Would you be willing to attend the Durham Spring School in 2021?

We would normally send out the booking form for the Spring School in November. We have booked **Deborah Campbell** ('The fine art of textiles' mixed media with stitch) and **Kate Barlow** (hand embroidery including silk shading, raised embroidery and goldwork techniques) as tutors. Further information is available upon request.

At the moment, we are unable to confirm the venue due to covid19 restrictions. But to facilitate the likelihood of being able to house the courses at Ushaw College, we are proposing to hold this school for the normal three days as a non-residential course. The sessions would run from 10.00am to 5.00pm on Wednesday, Thursday, probably finishing at 4.00 pm on Friday. You can attend as a day student or, if you wish, find your own accommodation. It is likely that Ushaw College will be able to provide bed and breakfast but they may not be able to offer an evening meal. Members would have to make their own arrangements with the College. The suggested cost will be £195 plus accommodation and kits.

We realise some of you may be reluctant to attend such a course so we would really appreciate some feedback before proceeding to arrange the courses.

Please let me have your views by December 16th – either 'Yes I am interested in attending Durham Spring School in 2021' or 'No, I am not willing to attend such a course in April 2021'. Contact me by email, chair.nerembguild@gmail.com or telephone 01748 886790.

If we get sufficient expressions of interest we will publish the details and booking form in January, asking for full payment initially. This will be fully refunded if the course cannot proceed.
